香港校園欺凌的情況不容忽視,據世界經濟合作暨發展 組織於2017年發表的報告,香港的校園欺凌問題是72個 受訪地區中最嚴重的;可惜的是,在過去多時這問題未 得到適切關注!

School-bullying amongst youths is a burning problem in Hong Kong! The Organisation for Economic Co-operation and Development reported that in 2017 Hong Kong was ranked as the worst for school bullying out of 72 countries and regions.

為了讓孩子及早糾正問題,安徒生會自2015年起聯同香港城市大學應用社會科學學系副教授馮麗姝博士推行「悅讀新視野」計劃,五年以來參與小學已達19間,累積受惠小學生超過900名,計劃特色是以社會資訊處理理論為基礎,進行十節以繪本為教育焦點的小組活動,讓學生透過故事理解別人情緒、學習換位思考及模仿正面良好行為,從而糾正他們扭曲了的思想,並由城大進行科學客觀的研究。結果反映此服務能有效提升學生的解決衝突和控制憤怒的能力,以及加強同理心和效能感,從而減低朋輩之間欺凌行為。

To provide an early intervention, our Agency has collaborated with Dr. Annis Fung, Associate Professor of Department of Social and Behavioural Sciences of City University of Hong Kong since 2015 to launch a "Read to Change" Project. Over the past 5 years, 900

students from 19 schools benefited from this project. Designed with the theoretical framework of "Social Information Processing" Model (SIP), groups with 10-session storytelling activities were used to educate students' understandings of others' emotions and thoughts and imitate the pro-social behavior. From the scientific and rational study from the City University of Hong Kong, the findings showed that the service effectively improved students' conflict resolution, anger control, empathy and competence. This leads to reduced bullying behaviors with their peers.

這項以社會資訊處理理論結合故事活動的實證為本服務,屬全球首創,並於2019年中於德國柏林一項國際學術會議中發表最新研究成果。我們在未來日子,將繼續整合知識和經驗,讓更多學生能夠在和諧的校園裏學習以關懷和包容去化解糾紛衝突。

Integrating SIP with storytelling programs, the present study is innovative and first of its kind, Dr. Fung presented the prominent result findings at a recent international conference held in Berlin, Germany. In the future, we strive for a further consolidation of the knowledge and experience to make more students experience acceptance and receive support in a harmonious campus.

In order to promote harmony among the cross generations and encourage children to care for the elders, this project aimed to enhance children's knowledge of the elders through different creative activities and drama trainings, and motivated them to make positive changes to the community by their own strengths.

成效 Impact

是次活動招募了77名7-12歲的兒童,其中 58.4%來自貧困家庭,10.4%學生有特殊教 育需要,另有97位長者受惠。

77 children aged 7-12 were recruited in this project. 58.4% of them came from low-income families and 10.4% of them were with special educational needs. 97 elders were benefited.


